Upon arrival at the Arlington National Cemetery Welcome Center, all visitors must go through physical security screening. Please leave ample time to arrive at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier for your ceremony.

You may access the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier by tram or by walking. Please plan your route ahead of time and note that the walk to the Tomb from the Welcome Center is approximately one mile, and mostly uphill.
